Governance & Bylaws

- Gave first reading to Bylaw No. 1117 Land Use Bylaw Amendment.
- Gave first reading to Bylaw No. 1115 Waste Management Bylaw.
- Gave first reading to Bylaw No. 1118 Animal Control Bylaw.

Finance & Grants

- Approved the Financial Report.
- Allow the Museum society to redirect seacan funding of \$22,800 previously approved in the 2026 capital budget to the train station roof repair and to approve an additional \$16,835 in funding from capital reserves in order to fully fund the train station roof repair.
- Approved the submission of an application for funding under the Alberta Community Partnership (ACP) program for the Pavement and Sidewalk Assessment Study project. Town of Sexsmith agrees to act as the Managing Partner and project lead for this initiative in collaboration with partner municipalities Town of Beaverlodge and Town of Wembley.

Policies

- Approve staff dress code policy 4.21 to include Summer Camp dress code as presented.

Economic Development
